Reasons for 15 th June opening	Nick thanked all for attending and explained actions for delayed opening (see Independent SAGE Committee meeting; 22 nd May)
Review of letters out to specific year groups	Nick ran through the letter sent out to parents on 27 th May
Run through of daily routine	<p>Annie and Nick ran through the daily timetable of events (not lessons) Key points emphasized through discussions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Half days only for the first week; this will be likely be mentally tiring for the children • Drop off at Drays Lane entrance (back gate) critical to success of transition. Staff will be waiting at the gate to give a warm welcome. Parents not to enter school site. Quick handover will be least distressful • No toys from home • Flexible with uniform but school cardigan/sweatshirt essential • School cannot guarantee children socially distancing. With the nature of the way children play, children will not be 2 metres away from each other • Staff will continue to have physical contact, if children are hurt, or need reassurance
If a child or adult displays symptoms at school	<p>Following Public Health guidelines;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The person will be removed from the room and isolated with a member of staff • Parents will be immediately contacted • School will inform all parents of children who have been in contact with that person • Public Health Thames Valley will be contacted by school and instructions will be communicated to all staff and parents
We request that children don't come into school if:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • They exhibit Covid19 symptoms • They exhibit cold/flu like symptoms (48 hours before return) • They have taken paracetamol/ibuprofen, as these will mask any symptoms 48 hours before return
Welcome video	Once our spaces have been set up, Annie and Kirsty will send out a video for the children to watch, so you can familiarize them with the site and
Monday 8 th June	Nick asked for all parents to inform school of their choice by this date, so that school can plan and prepare more readily
